Abstract

Hong Kong listed companies may be required to suspend trading for various reasons. While there are legitimate reasons such as dealing with sensitive information, there are also cases of involuntary suspension triggered by potentially non-compliance with listing rules or even signs of fraud and might sometimes result in prolonged suspension.

At the seminar, the speaker will highlight some key findings and conclusions drawn from Grant Thornton's latest fraud survey on Hong Kong listed companies, which summarizes the alleged fraudulent cases over the past 3 years. He will also evaluate various cases and offer some insights on how to bring suspended companies back on track.
