Most notably, he served six terms on the Board of Directors for ISACA International with over 150,000 members around the world. He was also the founder of the ACFE Hong Kong Chapter, and Chairman of the Nomination Committee for ACIIA (Asian Confederation of the Institute of Internal Auditors). Professor Yam currently serves as Governor of IIA Hong Kong and Certification Board member of the Hong Kong Institute for IT Professional Certifications.

Professor Yam is a very popular speaker of a wide variety of topics at seminars and conferences for professional organisations and government agencies, including many Central Banks, the INTERPOL and the Asian Development Bank.
